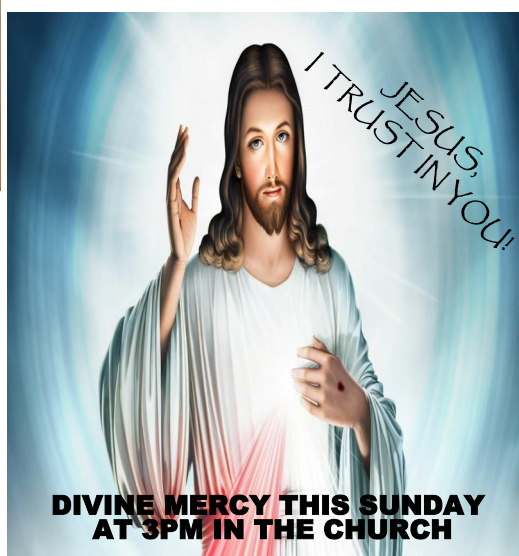

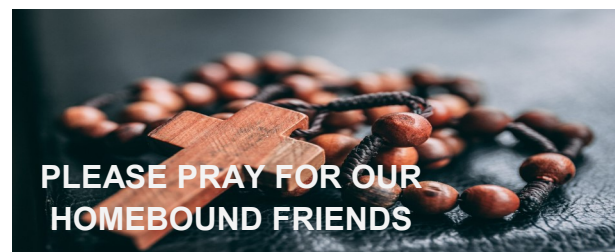

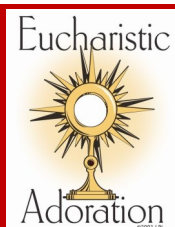
LEGION OF MARY

(PRACTICING) CATHOLIC RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

For all the condemnation Thomas the Doubter has received in 2000 years of homilies, I think there's something to admire in him. Thomas is not unique. We all waiver at some point, overcome by hesitation, distracted by the clamor of the world which seeks at every turn to shout above the whisper of the divine. Thomas knows what he saw on Good Friday: his friend nailed to a cross, a sword driven through his body. He saw the blood and the water. He saw these things with his own eyes, eyes given to him by God, eyes which have never failed him before. And God doesn't ask us to suspend reality to believe in Him. He only asks us to be discerning about how that reality is interpreted in our hearts. Thomas knows the man before him is either a fraud, preying on the hopes and anxieties of the traumatized disciples, or he is the Christ, the Savior of the world, accomplisher of impossible things. But where to look, to tell the difference? Satan once appeared to the great mystic saint, Teresa of Avila, disguised as Jesus. She knew instantly that he was a fraud. Enraged, he demanded to know where his deception had failed. "You have no wounds," she told him simply. Could we have accepted a savior who did not bleed? I don't think we could, because sooner or later, we would all stand before him and say, "Here is where the world hurt me. Here, and here, and here. What about you?" Christ can point to his hands, his feet, his side. "Here, and here, and here," he can say. "And I overcame them all." It's the wounds, you see. The truth is in the wounds. Thomas answered and said to him, "My Lord and my God!" — John 20:28—©LPi

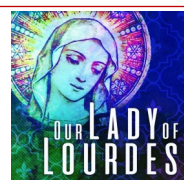
(PRACTICANDO) CATÓLICA: RECONOCE A DIOS EN TUS MOMENTOS ORDINARIOS

MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Greetings from Ridgecrest: Let us resume with the quotes from the priests' retreat: The next quote is, "In the words of King Henry VIII, speaking to his third wife: "Don't worry. I will not keep you long." That quote is not surprising, today. Many couples move in together without being married. Many couples are married only civilly. Many youths commit the sin of fornication before they get married. Many youths are watching porn and are not going to church. These actions are against the sixth and ninth commandments. According to Jacinta (one of the seers from Fatima), most people are in Hell because of the sin of the flesh. What must we do to counter this catastrophe? We educate ourselves, and we learn to practice morality. Parents must be the first educators of their children. This means that parents must know and practice the teachings of the Church. All the scenarios mentioned above are not accepted by the Church. Religious education should be a priority for children. A child must have a fundamental religious education. This means having some knowledge in sacred scriptures, prayer, the sacraments, Tradition, and Church doctrine. This will give the child a good fundamental basis of knowing, loving, and serving God. In addition, a catholic sex education must be given to them. They must know the dangers of what is being taught in society. A simple education of how the body operates, according to God's will is helpful. They must know and understand the beauty of the body. "Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore, honor God with your bodies (Corinthians 6:19-20). If we care about our children, we will properly educate them and be good examples to them. God bless.

Saludos desde Ridgecrest: Resumamos con las citas del retiro de los sacerdotes: La siguiente cita es: "En palabras del rey Enrique VIII, dirigiéndose a su tercera esposa: "No te preocupes. Muchos jóvenes cometen el pecado de fornicación antes de casarse. Muchos jóvenes están viendo pornografía y no van a la iglesia. Estas acciones van en contra del sexto y noveno mandamiento. Deben conocer los peligros de lo que se enseña en la sociedad. Es útil una educación sencilla de cómo funciona el cuerpo, de acuerdo con la voluntad de Dios. Deben conocer y comprender la belleza del cuerpo. "¿No sabéis que vuestros cuerpos son templos del Espíritu Santo, que está en vosotros, el cual habéis recibido de Dios? No eres tuyo; Fuiste comprado por un precio. Por lo tanto, honren a Dios con sus cuerpos (Corintios 6:19-20). The Eucharistic Miracles exhibit was designed by a young man from Italy by Blessed Carlo Acutis to spread awareness of the Eucharistic Miracles around the world. Since the actual relics and miracles cannot travel, the exhibit consists of Vatican-approved text and photographs and is arranged like an art exhibit. Throughout Christian history, our Lord has shown us that he is really present as the Blessed Sacrament. Interestingly, many Eucharistic miracles have occurred during times of weakened Faith. For instance, many Eucharist miracles have taken place as a result of someone doubting the Real Presence. Most Eucharistic miracles involve incidences in which the Host has "turned into human flesh and blood". Of course we as Catholics believe that the consecrated Host is the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of our Lord, under the appearances of bread and wine. Therefore, Jesus, through these miracles, merely manifests His Presence in a more tangible way. The exhibit contains a display of around forty of the Eucharistic Miracles from many countries, including Lanciano, Italy and Santarem, Portugal. These two miracles are considered by many to be the most important miracles involving the Eucharist. The exhibit is offered for adults and children in English and Spanish. Admission is free for everyone and you can bring the whole family. Donations will be gratefully accepted to help us bring these miracles to as many people as possible.
