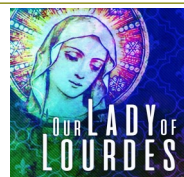

(PRACTICING) CATHOLIC RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Love in Deed

It's a Wonderful Life is one of my favorite Christmas movies. It only occurred to me recently, though, that this film, for all its yuletide aesthetic, is actually more of an Easter story. I love this movie because it's a very Catholic film — not overtly, although we do see the main character, George Bailey, going to Mass. No, it's the themes that are Catholic, not the set dressing. It's a story about the choices we make — to love, or not to love? To sacrifice, or not to sacrifice? To put oneself first, or to put oneself last? It's a story about what the consequences of those choices look like here in the world, and what they look like in heaven. In the film, we meet a young George Bailey who dreams of growing up to do amazing, impressive things. Over the years, he makes a choice here and he makes a choice there ... and when all is said and done, the adult George Bailey is a tired, overworked husband and father with no worldly attributes that anyone would envy. But he's a man who has loved in deed, not just in word, and who has reaped the spiritual rewards of those choices. The season of Easter is about rejoicing in true redemption, not in worldly triumph. The Word of God is not a bedtime story. It's a pruning shear. To hear it is to be changed, to be shaped. To live it is to lose some things, so that you might bloom in unexpected ways. To welcome the Word is to be willing to look different, to feel different. Anyone can say, "I love you, I accept you, I want to help you." But what does it actually look like, to love in deed and not just in word? It looks like giving something up: free time, wealth, comfort, worldly approval. It looks, to the casual observer, like pain. To someone who has no concept of how plants grow and thrive, a gardener's pruning shears look like an executioner's sword. To someone who has no concept of how souls grow and thrive, a tomb barred by a stone looks like the end of a story, when in fact it's just the beginning. Pero es un hombre que ha amado con hechos, no sólo con palabras, y que ha cosechado las recompensas espirituales de esas decisiones. La temporada de Pascua se trata de regocijarnos en la verdadera redención, no en el triunfo mundano. La Palabra de Dios no es un cuento antes de dormir. Es una tijera de podar. Escucharla es cambiar, ser formado. Vivirla es perder algunas cosas, para poder florecer de maneras inesperadas. Acoger la Palabra es estar dispuesto a verse diferente, a sentirse diferente. Cualquiera puede decir: "Te amo, te acepto, quiero ayudarte." Pero ¿cómo es realmente amar de hecho y no sólo de palabra? Se ve como renunciar a algo: tiempo libre, riqueza, comodidad, aprobación mundana. Al observador casual le parece doloroso. Para alguien que no tiene idea de cómo crecen y prosperan las plantas, las tijeras de podar de un jardinero parecen la espada de un verdugo. Para alguien que no tiene idea de cómo crecen y prosperan las almas, una tumba cerrada con una piedra parece el final de una historia, cuando en realidad es sólo el comienzo. MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Greetings from Ridgecrest: Let us resume with the quotes from the priests' retreat: The next quote is, "A contemplative (mystic) is someone who walks around with this crazy idea that God is madly in love with him." I don't think it is a crazy idea. God is madly in love with the mystic. I consider myself a contemplative. A contemplative person is a person who does contemplative prayer. It means taking time frequently to be alone with him who we know loves us (Saint Theresa of Avila / Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC 2709)). Contemplative prayer is the prayer of the child of God, of the forgiven sinner who agrees to welcome the love by which he is loved and who wants to respond to it by loving even more (CCC 2712). A contemplative person is a person who has tasted the Lord. Taste and see how good God is (Psalm 34:8). Two of the greatest mystics or contemplatives were Saint Theresa of Avila and Saint John of the Cross. They explain to us the different levels of prayer. Contemplation is a level of prayer. There are nine levels of prayer (Father Chad Ripperger). Contemplation is the fifth level of prayer (Eric Sammons). When one reaches contemplation, one does not give themselves prayer. God infuses prayer or contemplation in them. This means that God infuses grace and love into the whole being. It is a gift, a grace; it can be accepted only in humility and poverty. Contemplative prayer is a covenant relationship established by God within our hearts (CCC 2713). Unfortunately, most Catholics don't even reach the third level of prayer. Many Catholics only reach the second level of prayer which is meditation. If we want to be perfect as the Father is perfect (Matthew 5:48), we need to reach the transforming union which is the last level of prayer. We are all called to reach this highest form of prayer. God bless.

Saludos desde Ridgecrest: Resumamos con las citas del retiro de los sacerdotes: La siguiente cita es: "Un contemplativo (místico) es alguien que anda por ahí con esta loca idea de que Dios está locamente enamorado de él". No creo que sea una idea descabellada. Dios está locamente enamorado de lo místico. Me considero un contemplativo. Una persona contemplativa es una persona que hace oración contemplativa. Significa tomarse un tiempo frecuente para estar a solas con Aquel que sabemos que nos ama (Santa Teresa de Avila / Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica (CIC 2709)). La oración contemplativa es la oración del hijo de Dios, del pecador perdonado que acepta acoger el amor por el que es amado y que quiere responder a él amando aún más (CIC 2712). Una persona contemplativa es una persona que ha probado al Señor. Pruebe y vea cuán bueno es Dios (Salmo 34:8). Dos de los más grandes místicos o contemplativos fueron Santa Teresa de Avila y San Juan de la Cruz. Nos explican los diferentes niveles de oración. La contemplación es un nivel de oración. Hay nueve niveles de oración (Padre Chad Ripperger). La contemplación es el quinto nivel de la oración (Eric Sammons). Cuando uno llega a la contemplación, no se da a sí mismo oración. Dios infunde en ellos la oración o la contemplación. Esto significa que Dios infunde gracia y amor en todo el ser. Es un don, una gracia; sólo puede ser aceptada en la humildad y en la pobreza. La oración contemplativa es una relación de pacto establecida por Dios en nuestros corazones (CIC 2713). Desafortunadamente, la mayoría de los católicos ni siquiera alcanzan el tercer nivel de oración. Muchos católicos sólo alcanzan el segundo nivel de oración, que es la meditación. Si queremos ser perfectos como el Padre es perfecto (Mateo 5:48), necesitamos alcanzar la unión transformadora que es el último nivel de la oración. Todos estamos llamados a alcanzar esta forma más elevada de oración. Dios los bendiga.
